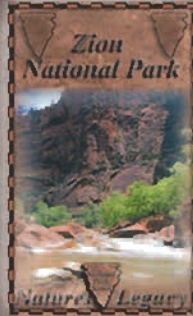
Glacier National Park

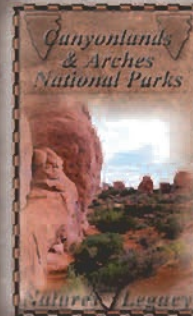
Zion National Park

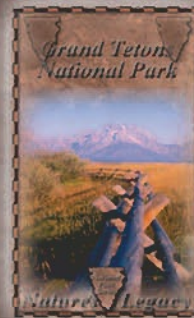
Canyonlands & Arches

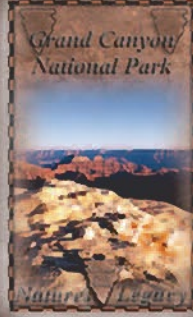
Grand Tetons National Park

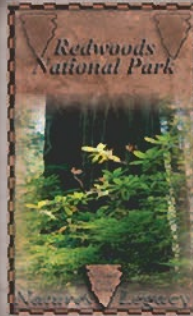
Grand Canyon National Park

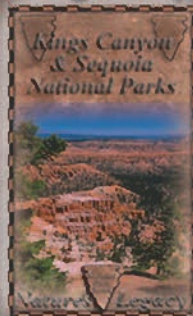
Mount Ranier National Park

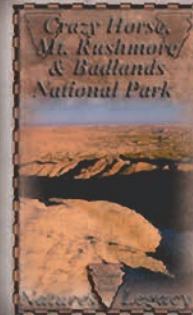
Kings Canyon & Sequoia National Park

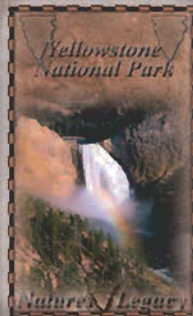
Crazy Horse, Mt Rushmore & Badlands
